Brian Hayden. *The Power of Feasts: From Prehistory to the Present* (New York: Cambridge University Press, 2014, 426 pp., 99 b/w figs., 6 maps, hbk, ISBN 978-1-107-04299-5, pbk, ISBN 978-1-107-61764-3)

Brian Hayden has been at the forefront of research on feasting for more than 20 years. His investigations have valuably informed the work of many prehistorians and anthropologists and contributed to the education and training of several generations of students. Together with other scholars (most prominently perhaps Michael Dietler) Hayden has contributed to the recognition of 'feasting' as a key activity in the history of human cultural evolution. Hayden and Dietler have coordinated interdisciplinary research on the subject for many years and produced an important edited volume dealing with feasting and its associated behavioural patterns (Dietler & Hayden, 2001). This is, however, the book we have really been waiting for—a full compendium of the history and evolution of feasting, integrating ethnographic and archaeological approaches. It is based on Hayden's many years of research on the subject, and it must undoubtedly be recognized as a formidable achievement.

The book is composed of nine chapters and includes several engaging black and white photographs, many taken by the author himself in the course of his numerous ethnographic and archaeological field trips. The reproduction is not always ideal but most are sufficiently clear. The first of the nine chapters sets the scene by providing some key definitions and discussing the core elements of Hayden's theoretical approach to the subject as well as introducing the main concepts that will be discussed in the book. The remaining chapters outline the historic development of feasting from primate behaviour until modern days. All chapters include surveys of ethnographic and archaeological literature (including first hand work by Hayden himself), each referring to the other line of evidence, thus providing a satisfactory level of integration.

Sensibly, Hayden's first concern is a clarification of the nature of his subject of investigation—feasts—which he defines as 'any sharing between two or more people
